<p>H2 train fire in countryside VR 3-B-1</p> 	<p>Provide guidance to the trainees on what they should observe</p>	<p>Trainees have to check the human rescue first</p> <p>Is someone threatened by the fire</p> <p>Trainees must remark the position of the fire</p> <p>Demand extra support</p>	
<p>H2 Bus Fire downtown VR 3-B-2</p> 	<p>You go with your team to urban downtown.</p> <p>What do you do during transit, when you arrive at the scene (information gathering) and how do you intervene to put out the fire safely?</p>	<p>Press the fuel cell emergency shutdown device if available</p> <p>Team 1: have a look to extract the victim(s) from the danger zone by any possible means (extraction tool : use the method implemented in the country). A pump-operated system might be safer than a battery-operated, however pump should be in safe zone and respect the distance with the car.</p> <p>Team 2: stretch a fire hoseline to protect the action of the Team 1 in case of an ignition of the cloud</p> <p>Demand extra support if necessary</p>	<p>0'31"</p>
